What is NIOS?

NIOS is an "Open School" to cater to the needs of a heterogeneous group of learners up to pre-degree level. It was started as a project with in-built flexibilities by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) in 1979. In 1986, the National Policy on Education Suggested Strengthening of Open School System for extending open learning facilities in a phased manner at secondary level all over the country as an independent system with its own curriculum and examination leading to certification.

Consequently, the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India set up the National Open School (NOS) in November 1989. The Pilot Project of CBSE on Open School was amalgamated with NOS Through a Resolution (No. F.5-24/90 Sch. 3 dated 14 September 1990 published in the Gazette of India on 20 Octorber 1990, the National Open School (NOS was vested with the authority to register, examine and certify students registered with it up to pre-degree level courses. In July 2002, the Ministry of Human Resource Development amended the nomenclature of the organisation from the National Open School (NOS) to the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) with a mission to provide relevant continuing education at school—stage, up to predegree level through Open Learning system to prioritized client groups as an alternative to formal system, in pursuance of the normative national policy documents and in response to the need assessments of the people, and through it to make its share of contribution.

What does NIOS do?

- Secondary Education Course

How does NIOS Function?

NIOS operates through a network of five Departments, Regional Centres and Accredited Institutions (Study Centres) in India and abroad. It has a current enrolment of about 4.2 million students at Secondary Senior Secondary & Vocational levels which makes it the largest open schooling system in the world.

For 12th Failed - Original Failed Marksheet/Original Admit Card, 10th Marksheet and passing Certificate (Photocopy), 6 coloured passport size Photographs & Guardian/Parents Address Proof(Photo Copy) except Driving Licence.

ADHAR Card Photo Copy Mandatory in Both. Photos Along with the Name and Current Date in Both.

3rd-4th Stream-(Save time, Save Year & Pass within 45 Days)

The Students Failed from any recognized board of India can also pass within 45 Days through on-Demand Examination System (ODES) of NIOS board in stream 3rd as well as 4th

For 12th Failed - Original Failed Marksheet / Original Admit Card, 10th Marksheet passing Cetificate (Photocopy) 6 Coloured passport size Photographs & Guardian/Parents Address Proof (Photo Copy) except Driving Licence.
